

COVID-19 Safety Plan

As always, your child's health and safety remain our top priority. Some of the children we work with are medically fragile or already respiratory compromised, so in order to allow us to re-open our doors, many changes are taking place.

We will be using the following protocols to do our part to keep everyone safe:

- All employees will be masked.
- Physical barriers will be used between clients and therapists on the table top. Where table top activities are not suitable, therapists will wear a clear face shield in addition to the mask.
- Furniture has been moved and spaces divided to allow for better adherence to social distancing procedures.
- Doors will be one-way with a designated entrance and exit to each space.
- Appointment times will be staggered and space will be left between appointments to limit the amount of people in common areas at the same time. Appointment times will be limited to 30 minutes for the time being due to decreased staff availability and social distancing procedures.
- We will continue to use the same disinfecting procedures we have always used to keep you safe. Surfaces and toys are wiped between clients with hospital grade disinfectant products. Our therapists are asked to wash or sanitize their hands between every client as well.
- Temperature screenings will occur for all employees and clients prior to entering the facility.
- Teletherapy appointments will continue to be offered in addition to office visits.

In order to keep the risk low for all of our children, we are asking for your cooperation with the following:

1. Please follow proper social distancing procedures while at the office and maintain 6 feet between you and other patrons as possible. Please limit to 1 family per time in the new reception area. If a family is already in the reception area, please wait to enter.
2. Sanitizer will be provided at the front desk. Please have your child wash their hands or sanitize prior to entering treatment spaces.
3. Masks are required for all adults. If your child will wear a mask, please have them do so. Once they are escorted to their therapy area, they may be asked to remove the mask if it will interfere with therapy. A clear plastic face shield may be provided to your child for the duration of their appointment as well.
4. Please follow our existing cancellation and sick policy. Cancellation fees are postponed for the foreseeable future. There will be no cost incurred for cancelled appointments at this time. **If anyone in your house has a fever, cough or sore throat, please stay home. Do not come to the office until everyone in your household has been symptom free for 3 days.**
5. In order to limit exposure, please limit the amount of people who come to therapy to one adult and refrain from having new/unfamiliar adults bring your child to sessions. We will work with you during this time to schedule at a time that is convenient for you.



6. We understand that siblings can not be left at home unattended. However, siblings will no longer be allowed to enter the treatment rooms to ensure that all materials used are able to be sanitized between clients.
7. The waiting room has been eliminated. You are welcome to accompany your child to the therapy room or wait outside. In addition to the front porch, there is a park behind our building.
